

A supermarket offering kosher products

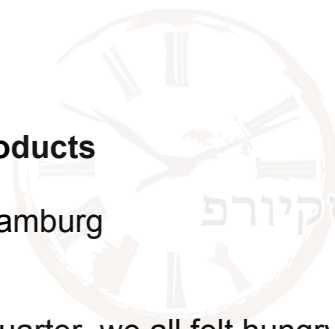
Location: Grindelallee 126, 20146 Hamburg

During our trip through the Grindel-quarter, we all felt hungry every once in a while. That's why we needed to find a place, where we could buy kosher food. If you try to find kosher food in Hamburg, you don't have that many possibilities to actually find a place, where you can buy it. But in this quarter of the town we found a store, which is part of a supermarket-group called EDEKA. It offers an assortment of over 100 food products, which are kosher. They are labelled with a blue sticker, which is the typical cachet for kosher food. The choice of kosher food ranges: from grapejuice and wine, to coffee, cacao or sweets from Haribo. And that's not it yet. It is planned to upgrade the assortment in the following years by adding milk, cheese, yoghurt and maybe even (frozen) meat.

Next to the EDEKA-store there is a bakery, which is called "Nur Hier". It's the only bakery-shop, which sells a sort of kosher bread that is called "Lüneburger".

The EDEKA-store at the Grindel-quarter probably is the only non-Jewish supermarket, which lies between Europe and Israel - and sells kosher products. Hopefully this business will expand.
